



## **ATS V4.1 Polygons Now Available**

The Government of Alberta has taken the March 2005 version of the Master ATS coordinate file, labeled it Version 4.1, and is using it as the base for Disposition Mapping. This file includes three points per section (N, NE, E), and has been available as a FREE download for over a year.

AltaLIS is pleased to release a GIS polygon file based on the V4.1 coordinates. Provincial coverage consists of five layers: LSD, Road Allowance,  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section, Section, and Township. The LSD product includes all five polygon layers for \$1000, and  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section product includes four layers for \$750.
